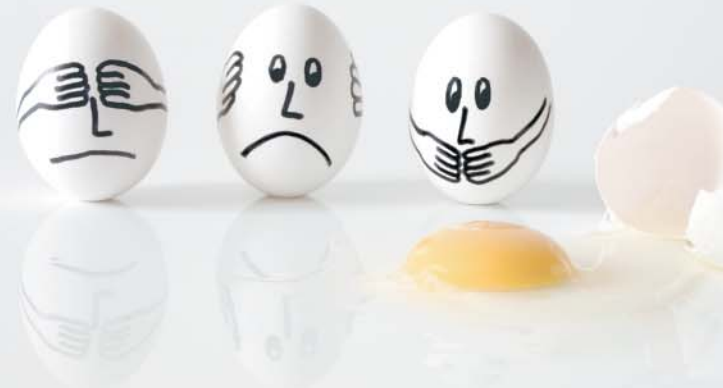

Have you experienced a Hate Incident or do you know someone who has? If so ...Report it

What is a Hate Incident?

A hate incident is any incident that is perceived by the victim or any other person as being motivated by the prejudice or hate of someone's...

- race, colour, ethnic origin, nationality or national origins
- religion
- gender or gender identity
- sexual orientation
- disability
- age

We want you to feel safe at home, at work and on the streets of South Worcestershire. If you or someone you know has been the victim of a hate incident, we need to know about it.

A Hate Incident Could include...

- Verbal abuse
- Harassment
- Graffiti or damage to property
- Threatening behaviour
- Offensive telephone calls or texts
- Hate mail or e-mail
- Physical assault
- Bullying at school or in the workplace

You do not have to tolerate hate and reporting any incident, no matter how minor can make a difference.

To report a hate incident just complete a reporting form and tell us as much information as you can. You can report anonymously if you wish, but we would like you to give your details so that we can help and support you.

You can make a report in person at many different locations such as: The Hub centres in South Worcestershire, Ethnic access link, Age Concern South Worcestershire, The CAB offices in South Worcestershire, WREC, Victim support, Worcester Community Housing.

If you wish, you can complete a reporting form online by going to www.worcester.gov.uk and clicking on the Report It section. You can also report directly to the Police via their True Vision website at www.report-it.org.uk

You can also telephone Worcestershire Hate Incident Partnership hotline to make a report on 01905 765945

The information about the incident will be recorded on our database to help us monitor what is happening in the city and identifying any areas of concern.

If you provide your details, you will be contacted by an officer within 6 working days of the report being received to discuss the incident further.

No personal information will be shared with any other agency without your consent. If you choose not to give your consent, then the report will only be used for monitoring purposes.
