

## Car Park safety and security advice

Many of the city council car parks and much of the city centre are covered by CCTV which is monitored by the police.

These car parks are also patrolled on a regular basis by our Parking Attendants to provide a safe and secure environment for the customer. Please help us and the police in reducing car crime by following the advice below.

### Do's and don'ts

- Always lock all doors and close all windows.
- Don't leave valuables in the car, if you must, lock them in the boot out of sight. If detachable remove the stereo.
- If you leave your vehicle overnight, choose a well lit place.
- Fit a car alarm and make sure it's on whenever you leave the car.
- Ensure that alloy wheels are protected with locking wheel nuts.
- After parking always check that the steering lock has engaged.
- Don't leave dogs in the car. We may request the police and RSPCA to break in to release the animal.

## Using the city council car parks

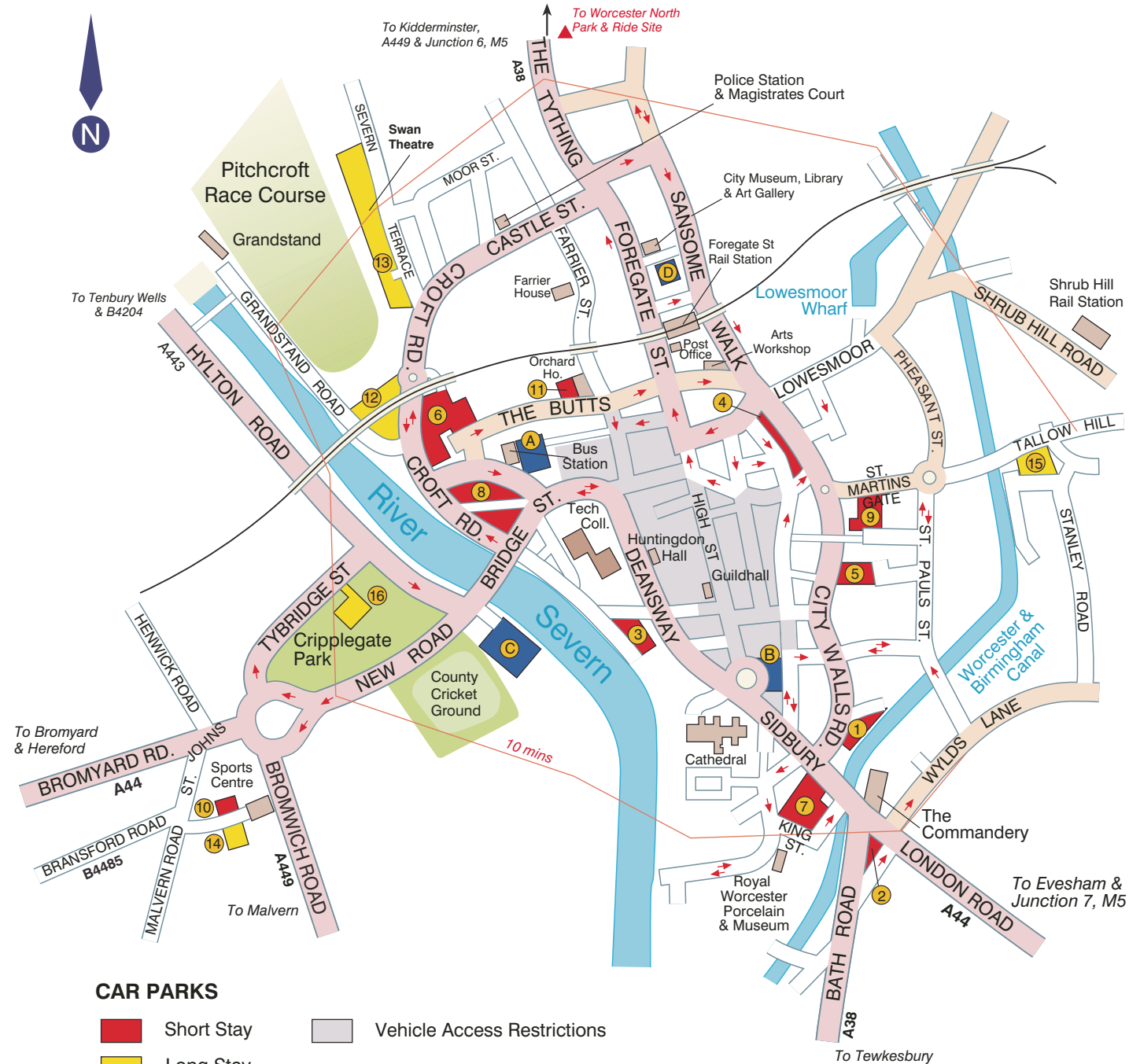
- 1 Enter the numeric part of the vehicle registration number into the machine; pay the appropriate fee allowing all the coins to register; check the machine display. *(If any coin fails to register retrieve it from the rejected coin slot and try it again)*; push the ticket issue button.
- 2 Parking tickets should be displayed inside the front windscreen with the expiry time and date etc. facing outwards.
- 3 The vehicle must not wait in a parking place for longer than the time printed on the parking ticket.
- 4 Always park within a marked bay *(i.e. between two lines)* - it is an offence not to do so. This also applies to disabled badge holders. Do not park in aisles or on yellow lines.
- 5 Pedal cycles and motor cycles can park free provided that they are parked in a space specifically designated for them.
- 6 **A disabled persons vehicle** displaying a **disabled persons badge** may park **in any marked bay** - although many car parks have some disabled bays outlined in yellow with a disabled logo on them. Disabled drivers may park for 3 hours on Short Stay car parks, free of charge. There are no time restrictions on Long Stay car parks.
- 7 The Parking Order and charges apply at all times.

- 8 **Worcester North Park & Ride.** Don't get caught in traffic use Worcester North Park & Ride site, A38 Droitwich Road. Open 7am - 7pm Mon-Sat. Buses run every 10 minutes 450 spaces, CCTV and on-site Security Staff. For more details ring: 01905 757692.
