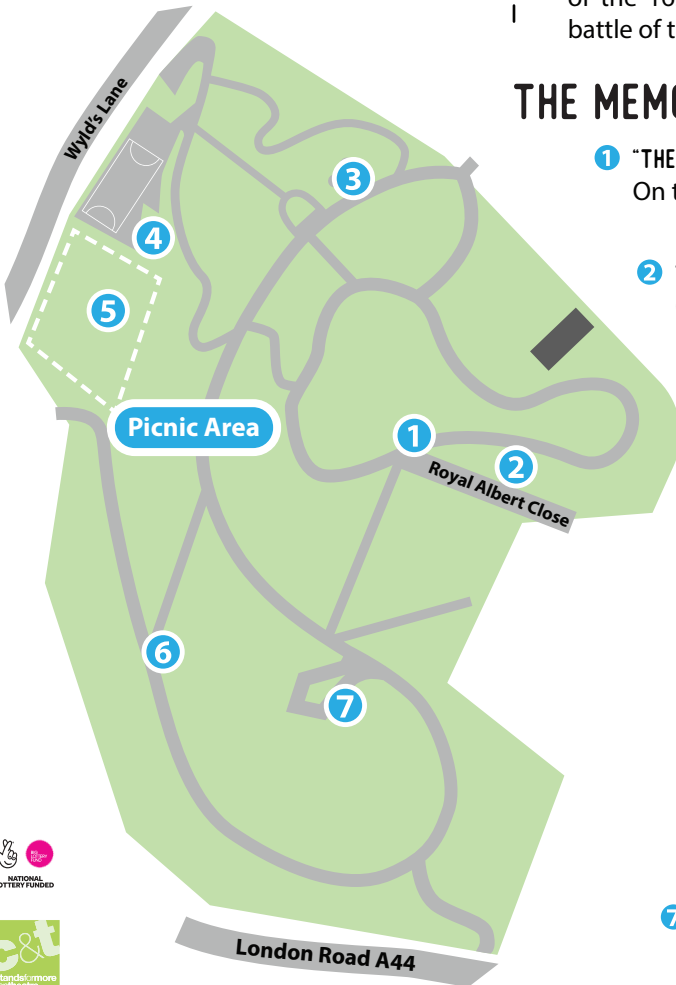
THE MEMORY TRAIL

Fort Royal Park is located south-east of Worcester within the Cathedral Ward of Worcester, with the main entrance being on Wylds Lane. Fort Royal Park is of critical historical significance to the city, as the site of the 1651 Battle of Worcester, the final battle of the English Civil War.

On the noticeboard at the top of the park.
- 3 "STANLEY ROAD PRIMARY 1"**
On the fort wall of the playground.
- 4 "JOHN STANLEY"**
On the concrete wall by the sports area.
- 5 "STANLEY ROAD PRIMARY 2"**
On the picnic bench near the court.
- 6 "HARISS SALEEM"**
On the bench near London Road side.
- 7 "ONE WORLD IN OUR PARK"**
On the bench near the canons.
