Adoption Statement for Accessibility Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) (Regulation 16 (2) and 19 of Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 (as amended 2008)).

This adopted statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 (as amended 2008).

The Accessibility Supplementary Planning Document forms part of Worcester City's Local Development Framework (LDF). The document sets out guidance on accessibility considerations for the implementation of policies within Worcester City's Local Plan (adopted 2004) within developments and guidance on how accessibility should be considered within the planning process.

Notice is hereby given that:

- a) On 1st March 2012 the Council adopted the Accessibility Supplementary Planning Document (SPD).
- b) That any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision, and
- (c) That any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the 1st March 2012, which is when the SPD was adopted.
